Objective:

The Long Branch Police Department's Citizens Police Academy (LB CPA) Class #6 will begin on March 20, 2018. The LB CPA is designed to provide members of the community with a greater understanding of the Long Branch Police Department and its operations. The LB CPA will consist of 8 weekly lectures given by guest speakers. Participants will receive in-the-field, hands-on experiences that may include ride-a-longs, firearms, K-9 demonstrations, tours of the Long Branch Police Department, and motor vehicle stops.

Our goal is to make the LB CPA an informative and enjoyable experience for all involved participants.

We are confident that graduates of the LB CPA will gain knowledge and awareness of the services offered by the Long Branch Police Department.

It is also an opportunity for the Police Department to learn from participants through discussion and interaction with speakers, instructors, and other classmates. The overall objective is to further strengthen police-community relations, so as to ensure that the City of Long Branch continues to be a great community to live, work, and raise our families.

Entrance Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old and of good character.
- Must provide information necessary for a criminal background check.
- Must be able to commit to attending all 8 classes.
- There is NO CHARGE to participate in the academy.

Academy Schedule:

The Long Branch Police Department conducts a spring and fall session of The Long Branch Citizens Police Academy. Each session is eight weeks in length, with classes meeting every Tuesday from 6:00-8:00 PM at Brookdale Community College, 213 Broadway. The eighth week of the Academy is a graduation ceremony, on a Tuesday, where LB CPA participants will be recognized. Family and friends are welcome to attend.
